CO2 injection to improve oil production started in the early 1970's in the U.S. What is the difference between CO2 injection for EOR vs. Carbon Sequestration? Do companies need to adjust? Isabelle Pelletier with Lapis Energy will talk about opportunities related to the technical needs as well as the business perspective.

Isabelle Pelletier started her Ph.D. in France at Institut Francais du Petrole (now IFPEN) in the 90's when interest in CCUS began. Major O&G companies had Research Departments and initiated efforts in CCUS. It started with the Sleipner Field in Norway, Weyburn Project in Canada, and CO2CRC Otway Project in Australia where injection started respectively in 1996, 2000, and 1998. Her majors were Geochemistry and Hydrogeology, which brought her into joining conversations related to dissolutions and precipitations incurred through injection and sequestration. Her career has spanned over 32 years in software development to O&G, and currently to CCS here in Dallas with Lapis Energy.
